I was troubled by the indignity in his eyes  
when I told him: "I could be arrested if any  
time so to be the best to you, can keep the work  
in case I am arrested." My confusion went  
away when I ~~found~~ <sup>found</sup> out the member of the intelligence  
force working for me at the abortion.

I never mentioned the role of the company where  
I worked for years in giving me up to the security  
force because I hoped that they would, one day,  
admit to promote the idea they had and take  
responsibility for it. But to say that they were  
responsible for it, that is to say that they were  
responsible for the abortion in justifying  
the outrage. It is not to say participating in it.

How can you hold for refusing to give up somebody else  
when would the force need such a prisoner? Is possibly  
if he will one of their illegal supporters?

But I understand the fear and panic to at least some  
national establishments to support totalitarian rights to  
when supported by young people ambitious people who  
know how to see "no" in front of people who will resist to  
any "up". I also understand their fear of life and the inevitable  
loss of freedom.

In the end, I thank the publisher management  
for contributing to giving me the chance of joining more than  
200,000 of my brother and sister prisoners in my homeland
