


THE FUN STARTS!

The big idea is to start with a "form." Then develop other "forms" on it. Build your final lines in by selecting, eliminating the lines you do not use. I leave mine in to show how it's done.

Now we're ready to begin. Start with a simple oval. Sketch more if you like or alter

Any shape will do. Set the working principle. Remember the sides of the face should match. Do not make one cheek or ear larger than the other.

All blue lines are light lines. When drawn in as guidelines, draw them close to the face and then bang in the heavy lines for the final drawing.



Draw fairly large. Since your shapes are your own, you can ignore the rules.
