

HOW TO PROJECT FURNITURE ONTO THE GROUND PLANE

Here is an excellent method for building furniture and figures on a ground plane. It is simpler

Draw a square or rectangle. Then square it off. Plan the size and positions of the furniture and figures. Establish a base line across your plan and a horizon above it. Carry the division up the base line to the furnishing point. The depth of first square is optional (square 1). Establish measuring line by drawing diagonal thru square 1. When it cuts other dimension lines mark off the depths of the other squares. Number all squares and each line and point can be thus located. Now establish heights from any desired order manner described page 99.
