Inkscape and GIMP use the same color palette called "GIMP Palette" which is a document with ".gpl" and can be made with any text editor.

For example,

at left side, you can see the content of "Pastels.gpl" which includes the name "Pastels" and 18 RGB colorcodes.

You can make your own color palette by rewriting the parts surrounded in a red circle and saving it with ".gpl".

And then, copy and paste the gpl file (in case of GIMP)

into "GIMP2>share>gimp>2.0>palettes folder"

(in case of Inkscape)

into "Inkscape>share>palettes folder".
