STOCKS CRASH IN RUSH TO SELL; BILLIONS LOST

Morgan, Mitchell Buying
Stocks in Effort to
Check Rush to Unload

New York, Oct. 24.—In a panic today with no one to catch it, the stock market crashed in a rush to sell, with billions of dollars lost. The crash began in the morning when the market opened at a level of 100 for the Dow Jones industrial average. By noon, the market had fallen to 80, and by 2 p. m. it had reached a low of 60. The crash was the result of a combination of factors, including the announcement that the Federal Reserve bank had raised the discount rate to 6 percent, and the fact that many investors had been expecting a rise in the market. The crash was the worst since the panic of 1907, and it led to a period of economic depression that lasted for several years.
